

EMAW Book 1 Day #1 & 27 **Love God and others.**

Mark 12:28-31 ²⁸ *One of the scribes came and...asked Him, "What commandment is the foremost of all?"* ²⁹ *Jesus answered, "The foremost is,..."* ³⁰ *AND YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH.'* ³¹ *The second is this, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'* ... EMAW Book 1 #2 & 28 **The Scripture thoroughly equips you for every good work.**

EMAW Book 1 #3 & 29 **You will be successful if you meditate day and night.**

Joshua 1:8 *This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.* Joshua 1:8

EMAW Book 1 #4 & 30 **If you don't ask, you don't receive.**

John 16:24 *Until now you have asked for nothing in My name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be made full.* John 16:24

EMAW Book 1 #5 & 31 **Don't worry about anything, but pray about everything.**

Philippians 4:6-7 ⁶ *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.* ⁷ *And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.* Philippians 4:6-7

EMW Book 1 #6 **Listen to the Word and do what it says.**

James 1:22 *But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.* James 1:22

EMAW Book 1 #7 **Discipline is not pleasant, but produces a harvest of righteousness.**

Hebrews 12:11 *All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.* Hebrews 12:11

EMAW Book 2 #8 **You, as a man, are out of balance and need a helper.** Genesis 2:18 *Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him."* Genesis 2:18

EMAW Book 2 #9 **Give up your life for your wife.**
Ephesians 5:25 *Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,* Ephesians 5:25

EMAW Book 2 #10 **My Marriage Commitment**
It is my privilege, to show my love for Jesus by caring for my wife- to love her, show her honor, try to understand her and to give up my life and rights for her. My Marriage Commitment

EMAW Book 2 #11 **When you suffer, go to God, and do what's right.**
1 Peter 4:19 *Therefore, those also who suffer according to the will of God shall entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right.*

EMAW Book 2 #12 **Grant your wife honor.**
1 Peter 3:7 *You husbands in the same way, live with your wives in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered.* 1 Peter 3:7

Three Biblical principles for raising children:

Three Biblical principles for raising children:

EMAW Book 2 #14 **Fathers, it is your responsibility to train your children.**

Ephesians 6:4 *Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.* Ephesians 6:4

EMAW Book 2 #15 **The tongue has the power of life and death.**

Proverbs 18:21 *Death and life are in the power of the tongue...*

Proverbs 18:21

EMAW Book 2 #16 **If you do all the talking and don't listen, shame on you.**

Proverbs 18:13 *He who gives an answer before he hears,*

It is folly and shame to him. Proverbs 18:13

EMAW Book 2 #17 **If someone hurts you, pay him back with blessing.**

1 Peter 3:8-9 ⁸ *To sum up, all of you be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kindhearted, and humble in spirit; ⁹ not returning evil for evil or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing.* 1 Peter 3:8-9

EMAW Book 3 #18 **The deceitfulness of wealth chokes the Word.**

Mark 4:19 *but the worries of the world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things enter in and choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.* Mark 4:19

EMAW Book 3 #19 **If you borrow money, you lose your freedom.**

Proverbs 22:7 *The rich rules over the poor,*

And the borrower becomes the lender's slave. Proverbs 22:7

EMAW Book 3 #20 **Spread your investments around to seven or eight places.**

Ecclesiastes 11:2 *Divide your portion to seven, or even to eight, for you do not know what misfortune may occur on the earth.* Ecclesiastes 11:2

EMAW Book 3 #21 **If you've got wealth, don't put your hope in it.**

1 Timothy 6:18-19 ¹⁸ *Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, ¹⁹ storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed.* 1 Timothy 6:18-19

EMAW Book 3 #22 **Trials bring you to maturity so you lack nothing.**

James 1:2-4 ² *Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. ⁴ And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.* James 1:2-4

EMAW Book 3 #23 **Are you weary and tired? God's yoke is easy.**

Matthew 11:28-30 ²⁸ "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. ³⁰ For My yoke is easy and My burden is light." Matthew 11:28-30

EMAW Book 3 #24 **Do you want to make your life count? Make disciples!**

Matthew 28:18-20 ¹⁸ And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." EMAW Book 3 #25 **Glorify God in your body.**

1 Corinthians 6:20 *For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.* 1 Corinthians 6:20

EMAW Book 3 #26 **Do your work heartily as for the Lord!**

Colossians 3:23-24

²³ *Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men,* ²⁴ *knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.* Colossians 3:23-24
